<sup>17</sup> For I am about to create new heavens  
and a new earth;

the former things shall not be  
remembered or come to mind.

<sup>18</sup> But be glad and rejoice for ever  
in what I am creating;

for I am about to create Jerusalem as a  
joy, and its people as a delight.

<sup>19</sup> I will rejoice in Jerusalem,  
and delight in my people;  
no more shall the sound of weeping be  
heard in it,  
or the cry of distress.

<sup>20</sup> No more shall there be in it  
an infant that lives but a few days,  
or an old person who does not live  
out a lifetime;  
for one who dies at a hundred years will  
be considered a youth,  
and one who falls short of a hundred  
will be considered accursed.

<sup>21</sup> They shall build houses and inhabit  
them;  
they shall plant vineyards and eat  
their fruit.

<sup>22</sup> They shall not build and another  
inhabit;  
they shall not plant and another eat;  
for like the days of a tree shall the days  
of my people be,  
and my chosen shall long enjoy the  
work of their hands.

<sup>23</sup> They shall not labour in vain,  
or bear children for calamity;

for they shall be offspring blessed by the  
LORD—

and their descendants as well.

<sup>24</sup> Before they call I will answer,  
while they are yet speaking I will  
hear.

<sup>25</sup> The wolf and the lamb shall feed  
together,  
the lion shall eat straw like the ox;  
but the serpent—its food shall be  
dust!

They shall not hurt or destroy  
on all my holy mountain,  
says the LORD.



GOSPEL: Luke 6: 35 - 38 (GNT)

<sup>35</sup> No! Love your enemies and do good  
to them; lend and expect nothing back.  
You will then have a great reward, and  
you will be children of the Most High  
God. For he is good to the ungrateful  
and the wicked. <sup>36</sup> Be merciful just as  
your Father is merciful.

<sup>37</sup> “Do not judge others, and God will  
not judge you; do not condemn others,  
and God will not condemn you; forgive  
others, and God will forgive you. <sup>38</sup> Give  
to others, and God will give to you.  
Indeed, you will receive a full measure, a  
generous helping, poured into your  
hands—all that you can hold. The  
measure you use for others is the one  
that God will use for you.”
