GOSPEL: John 11: 32—44 (NLT)

³² When Mary arrived and saw Jesus, she
fell at his feet and said, "Lord, if only you
had been here, my brother would not
have died."

³³ When Jesus saw her weeping and saw
the other people wailing with her, a deep

anger welled up within him, and he was
deeply troubled. ³⁴ "Where have you put
him?" he asked them.

They told him, "Lord, come and
see." ³⁵ Then Jesus wept. ³⁶ The people
who were standing nearby said, "See
how much he loved him!" ³⁷ But some
said, "This man healed a blind man.
Couldn't he have kept Lazarus from
dying?"

³⁸ Jesus was still angry as he arrived at
the tomb, a cave with a stone rolled
across its entrance. ³⁹ "Roll the stone
aside," Jesus told them.

But Martha, the dead man's sister,
protested, "Lord, he has been dead for
four days. The smell will be terrible."

⁴⁰ Jesus responded, "Didn't I tell you that
you would see God's glory if you
believe?" ⁴¹ So they rolled the stone
aside. Then Jesus looked up to heaven
and said, "Father, thank you for hearing
me. ⁴² You always hear me, but I said it
out loud for the sake of all these people
standing here, so that they will believe
you sent me." ⁴³ Then Jesus

shouted, "Lazarus, come out!" ⁴⁴ And
the dead man came out, his hands and
feet bound in graveclothes, his face
wrapped in a headcloth. Jesus told
them, "Unwrap him and let him go!"
