GOSPEL: John 2: 1 - 11 (NLT)

The next day there was a wedding
celebration in the village of Cana in
Galilee. Jesus' mother was there,² and
Jesus and his disciples were also invited
to the celebration.³ The wine supply ran
out during the festivities, so Jesus'
mother told him, "They have no more
wine."

⁴ "Dear woman, that's not our
problem," Jesus replied. "My time has not
yet come."

⁵ But his mother told the servants, "Do
whatever he tells you."

⁶ Standing nearby were six stone water
jars, used for Jewish ceremonial washing.
Each could hold twenty to thirty
gallons.⁷ Jesus told the servants, "Fill the
jars with water." When the jars had been
filled,⁸ he said, "Now dip some out, and
take it to the master of ceremonies." So
the servants followed his instructions.

⁹ When the master of ceremonies tasted
the water that was now wine, not
knowing where it had come from
(though, of course, the servants knew),
he called the bridegroom over.¹⁰ "A host
always serves the best wine first," he
said. "Then, when everyone has had a lot
to drink, he brings out the less expensive
wine. But you have kept the best until
now!"

¹¹ This miraculous sign at Cana in Galilee
was the first time Jesus revealed his
glory. And his disciples believed in him.
